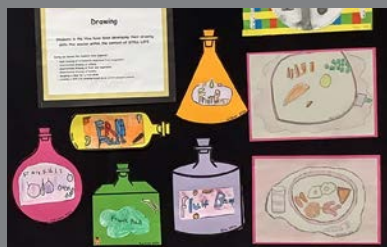

Dear Parent/Carer,

We had excellent attendance at our recent S2 parent consultation by parents and pupils. It was great to see the valuable discussions taking place, just before course choice starts. I would encourage all of our young people to consider the national qualifications they want, or indeed need to study, when selecting their courses for S3. The subjects selected from S2 into S3 will play an integral part in the following year's course choice, from S3 into S4.

A reminder to all that our Careers and Curriculum Convention will take place on Tuesday 21st November from 5pm-7:30pm. There will be 43 stalls from industry, college and universities who will be on hand to answer questions you may have about their sector. We will also have all of our departments on show, who will be available to discuss pathways through their curricular area, and into employment or further and higher education. SLT will also present information about the course choice process, the different types of qualifications and curriculum reform. The aim of this event is to ensure all pupils and families leave the evening feeling better informed, before making important decisions around national qualifications and next steps. A final reminder that this event is open to all year groups.

On Friday last week we remembered those military personnel who lost their lives in the line of duty, during World War I, but also those affected by conflicts around the world today. The School Captains led us in a minute of silence at 11 a.m. to honour the sacrifices of soldiers, including past pupils and teachers of Dalkeith High School.

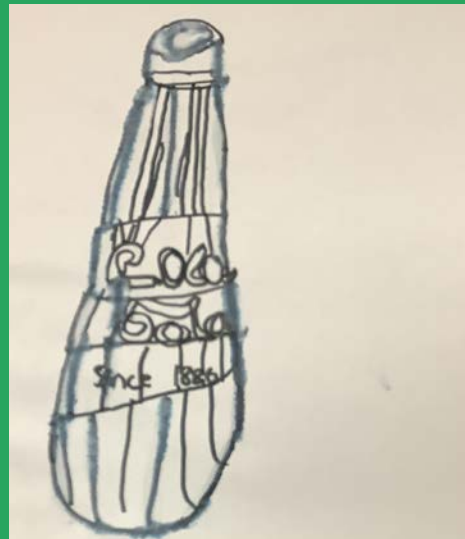

On the evening of Tuesday 21 November, we will be combining with St David's High School and DYW Scotland to stage this year's Careers Fair.

Supplementing the Careers Fair, and new in format this year, is our Dalkeith High School Curriculum Pathways Evening.

Timings for the night are below.

The careers fair offers the opportunity to browse over 40 stalls set up by employers, apprenticeship providers, universities and further education providers, as well as stalls set up by local organisations offering post-school support. The time and space will be available for parents, carers and pupils to talk to experts about the pathways open to young people on leaving school.

Running alongside the Careers Fair, our Curriculum Pathways Evening will offer informative talks on the curriculum in S3 and the senior phase. And even more: teachers from all the departments in the school will be on hand to provide information and advice about the pathways through the subjects and experiences they offer.
