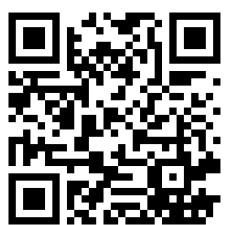
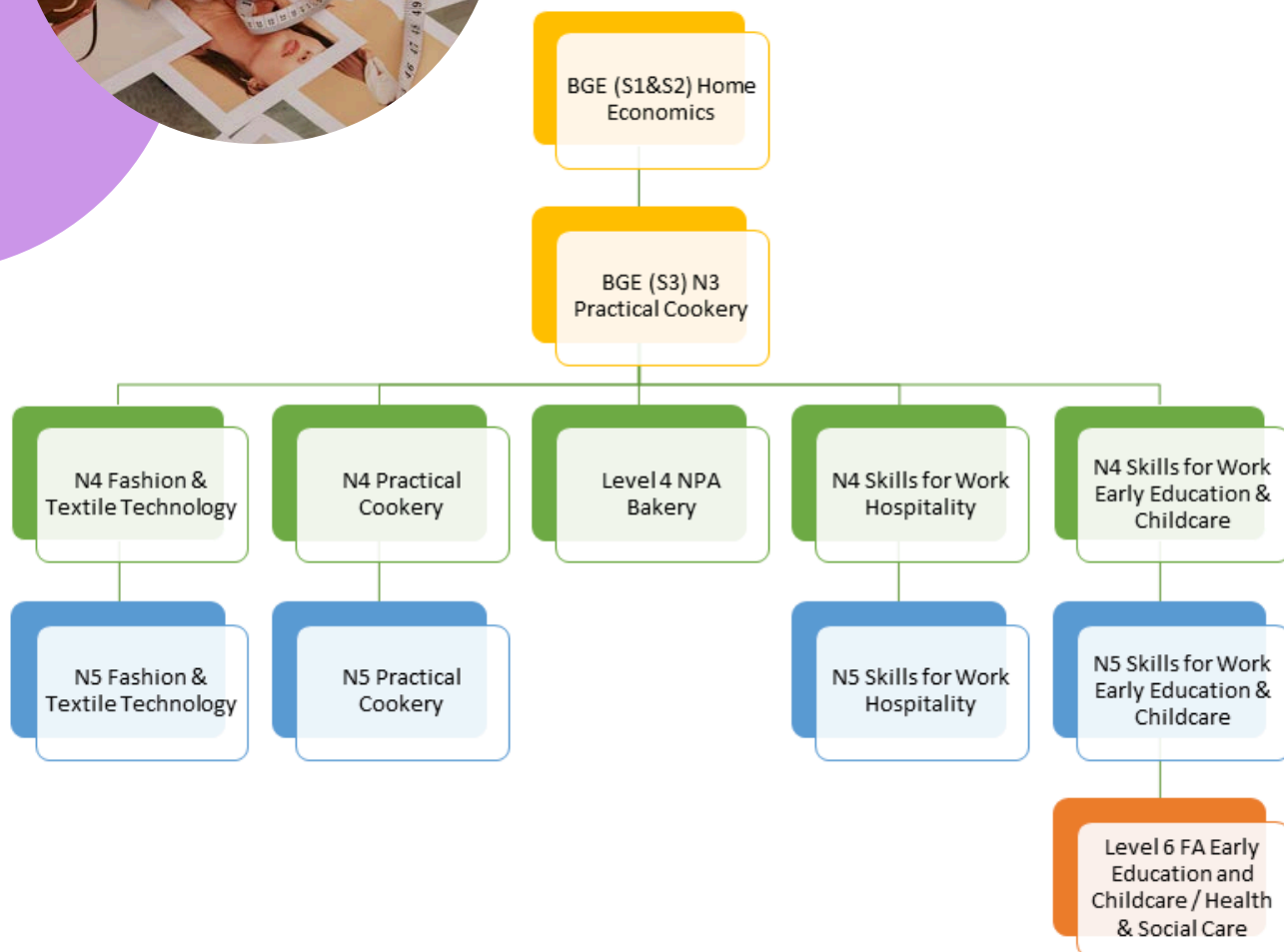


Pathways within school
